Elk Haven Horse Camp is located in the heart of the Black Hills, a 6,000 square mile mountain oasis in a sea of prairie. This relatively small area is home to one of the best vacation destinations in the country, boasting hundreds of trails, attractions and stunning natural beauty all within a 100-mile radius. Besides the miles and miles of horseback riding trails, there are other adventures that await you while in the Black Hills – (listed mileage is from Elk Haven).

South Dakota State Parks:

Western South Dakota boasts 6 state parks, the largest and most visited is Custer State Park whose northern boundary is only one mile from Elk Haven!

- Angostura State Recreation Area: This reservoir located in the Southern Black Hills is a great place for swimming, boating, or fishing. 55 miles
- <u>Custer State Park:</u> 71,000 acres of spectacular scenery, wildlife viewing, fishing, hiking, swimming, and naturalist programs. The park is also home to one of the nation's largest bison herds. <u>www.custerstatepark.info</u> 1 mile
- <u>George S. Mickelson Trail:</u> 109-mile long trail that follows the historic Deadwood to Edgemont Burlington Northern rail line. Enjoyed by hikers and bikers the trail has over 100 converted rail bridges, 4 rock tunnels, and 14 trailheads. www.mickelsontrail.com 20 miles
- <u>Bear Butte State Park:</u> A solitary mountain east of Sturgis that served as a pioneer landmark and continues its role as a holy mountain and founding place religion for many Plains Indian Tribes. https://gfp.sd.gov/parks/detail/bear-butte-state-park/ 65 miles
- Rocky Point State Recreation Area: Located in the Northern Black Hills is the Belle Fourche Reservoir an 8,000 acre fishing haven created by Orman Dam. While principally used for irrigation it is a popular destination for walleye fishers 80 miles
- Roughlock Falls State Park: 50-foot cascading waterfall in stunning Spearfish Canyon. Complete with trails, catwalks, viewing nodes, picnic area, and restrooms 65 miles
